

Introduction

In keeping with Em's spirit of giving, the Emmy Duff Scholarship Foundation is dedicated to providing scholarships to deserving students. The Scholarships will support post-secondary academic endeavours and recognize your personal triumphs.

The \$2,000 Emmy Duff Scholarship is a one-time award for full-time students in a college or university program in Canada. Students may be in any year of their studies provided that they are enrolled in a college or university program for the 2023 fall term.

We will post the names of the recipients of the Scholarship on our website in August 2023.

Eligibility

The Emmy Duff Scholarships (\$2,000 each) are open to students who:

- Are currently attending or will be attending a Canadian university or college program for the 2023/2024 academic year. Confirmation of enrolment as a full-time or part time student will be required for the successful recipients.
- Are in any year of your studies;
- Are resident of and currently residing in Canada;
- Have demonstrated an ongoing volunteer commitment to causes that are important to you;
- Have undergone treatment or are currently being treated for cancer.

Required Documents

- Completed application form (3 pages). Only 2023/2024 application forms will be accepted.
- Statement from your oncologist or current physician confirming that you were treated (or are currently receiving treatment) for a cancer diagnosis. A statement is not required if you have applied in a previous year.
- 300-500 word letter describing your personal life experience, your future goals, and why you are applying for this scholarship. Please include any details that you feel are relevant.
- For the applicants selected, we will require your letter of acceptance from the Canadian postsecondary institution you will be attending in September 2023, or confirmation that you will be attending a college or university in 2023/2024.

Deadline for Submission

Friday, May 26, 2023 (Applications received after this date will not be accepted).
